

## SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR 2020 - 2021 SESSION

Thank you for your enrollment and your cooperation as we implement safety guidelines for the 2020 - 2021 Session. Things may look a bit different from the outside but the same caring, kind-hearted attitude of our staff has remained, and we are thrilled to connect with our students again.

### REGISTRATION/PAYMENTS

All class and event registrations are online and may be accessed through our website (New Students) or your Parent Portals (Current Students). Registrations will not be accepted at the front desk. Payments may be made through your Parent Portals. ### DROP OFF/PICK UP

We will be utilizing both sets of doors in an effort to keep student traffic flowing. Dropoff will be at our main entrance and pickup will be at our side exit located on the east side of the building. Staff will be manning the east exit and re-entry will not be permitted.

Students enrolled in *3 and 4 year old classes* will be escorted to and from their classes by staff. These classes will now be held in Studios 1 and 2 to allow for parent viewing from the exterior front of the building. We ask that parents of this age remain on site in the case that we need you to assist your child.

Students enrolled in levels *Rookie (Age 5+) and above* are expected to enter and exit the building independently.

### SANITIZATION STATIONS

Upon entering the building, students will be asked to use hand sanitizer. Should a student leave a studio room and return, they will be asked to re-sanitize prior to reentry. Handwashing is always encouraged in addition to hand sanitization.

Temperatures will be monitored prior to the students and teachers entering the studio and should be below 100 degrees. It is imperative that you please keep your dancer home if they are experiencing any symptoms or have been in contact with any ill person.

### LOBBY

The lobby will be closed, and parents will be asked to please wait outside. Students will not be allowed to loiter in hallways and should arrive for their classes just a few minutes prior to class start times.

### SOCIAL DISTANCING/MASKS

We ask that everyone please be respectful of personal space and contact with staff, other students and families. Masks are required for students and staff at this time.

Should students need to briefly wait in the hallway or lobby at class change times, markers have been placed onto flooring to aid with social distancing. Markers/grids have also been placed in all dance studios to champion this cause as well.

### BACKPACKS/WATER

Students are asked to only bring shoes needed for that night of classes. **Large backpacks will not be allowed at this time.** Small string/breathable bags are encouraged and they will remain with the students in their respective studio and should be placed on the designated white markers along the perimeter of the room. Cell phones should be turned off and remain in bags.

Water fountains will be disabled and students will need to bring their own water bottles. Water will be available for purchase (\$1), if needed. Water will be the only beverage allowed inside studios.

### ATTIRE/SHOES/HAIR

The locker room availability is limited and students will not be allowed to congregate in this area. During this time, students should wear appropriate dance attire requiring little to no clothing changes.

Dancers should change into proper footwear upon entering the building. No bare feet or street shoes are allowed in the dance studios.

Hair should be pulled back and away from the dancers faces decreasing contact and excessive touching of the eyes, mouth and nose as recommended.

We ask for your patience and cooperation during this time.
