

SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR SUMMER 2021

Thank you for your enrollment and your cooperation as we continue to utilize safety guidelines for the 2021 Summer Session.

REGISTRATION/PAYMENTS

All class and event registrations are online and may be accessed through our website (New Students) or your Parent Portals (Current Students). Registrations will not be accepted at the front desk. Questions will be handled via phone (469)742-0383 or through our email at info@danceatelevate.com. *Please refer to our website for Summer 2021 Session pricing and payment information details.*

DROP OFF/PICK UP

We will be utilizing both sets of doors in an effort to keep student traffic flowing. Dropoff will be at our main entrance and pickup will be at our side exit located on the east side of the building. Staff will be manning the east exit and re-entry will not be permitted.

Students enrolled in 3 -5 year old combo classes will be escorted to and from their classes by staff. We ask that parents of this age group remain on site in the case that we need you to assist your child.

SANITIZATION STATIONS

Upon entering the building, students will be asked to use hand sanitizer. Should a student leave a studio room and return, they will be asked to re-sanitize prior to reentry. Handwashing is always encouraged in addition to hand sanitization.

Temperatures will be monitored prior to the students and teachers entering the studio and should be below 100 degrees. It is imperative that you please keep your dancer home if they are experiencing any symptoms or have been in contact with any ill person.

LOBBY

The lobby will remain closed, and parents will be asked to please wait outside. However, if you have a student age 5 or under AND their class is scheduled in Studio 5, ONE parent will be allowed to wait in the lobby to watch class. This studio does not have exterior windows.

SOCIAL DISTANCING/MASKS

We ask that everyone please be respectful of personal space and contact with staff, other students and families. Masks are optional for students and staff at this time.

BACKPACKS/WATER

Students are asked to only bring shoes needed for that night of classes. **Large backpacks will not be allowed at this time.** Small string/breathable bags are encouraged and they will remain with the students in their respective studio and should be placed on the designated white markers along the perimeter of the room. ***Cell phones should be turned off and remain in bags.***

Water fountains will be disabled and students will need to bring their own water bottles. Water will be available for purchase (\$1), if needed. Water will be the only beverage allowed inside studios.

ATTIRE/SHOES/HAIR

The locker room availability is limited and students will not be allowed to congregate in this area. During this time, students should wear appropriate dance attire requiring little to no clothing changes.

Hair should be pulled back and away from the dancer's faces, decreasing contact and excessive touching of the eyes, mouth and nose as recommended.
